Description	nerve growth factor(NGF) Homo sapiens This gene is a member of the NGF-beta family and encodes a protein which homodimerizes and is incorporated into a larger complex. This protein has nerve growth activity and the complex is involved in the regulation of growth and the differentiation of sympathetic and sensory neurons. Mutations in this gene have been associated with hereditary sensory and autonomic neuropathy type 5 (HSAN5), and dysregulation of this gene's expression is associated with allergic rhinitis. Protein Function	disease:Defects in NGF are the cause of hereditary sensory and autonomic neuropathy type 5 (HSAN5) [MIM:608654]. The hereditary sensory and autonomic neuropathies are a genetically and clinically heterogeneous group of disorders characterized by degeneration of dorsal root and autonomic ganglion cells, and by sensory and/or autonomic abnormalities. HSAN5 patients manifest loss of pain perception and impaired temperature sensitivity, ulcers, and in some cases self-mutilation. The autonomic involvement is variable.,function:NGF is an important growth factor for the development and maintenance of the sympathetic and sensory nervous system. It stimulates division and differentiation of sympathetic and embryonic sensory neurons.,online information:NGF is a growth factor entry,similarity:Belongs to the NGF-beta family.,subunit:Homodimer.,
