Parvalbumin Antibody, pAb, Rabbit

Description:

Parvalbumin (PV) is a calcium binding protein. It belongs to a larger group of EF hand proteins and consists of a single, unbranched chain of linked amino acids. Parvalbumin participates in the decay of calcium in the contraction/relaxation cycle of fast twitch muscles. And it is implicated in maintaining the balance between excitation and inhibition in the cortex as well as in the hippocampus. It is also expressed in specific muscle fibers and fast-firing neurons.

GenScript **Rabbit Anti-Parvalbumin Polyclonal Antibody** is developed in rabbit using purified His-tagged human Parvalbumin (Swiss Prot: P20472) full length recombinant protein.

Formulation:

0.5 mg/ml, lyophilized with PBS, pH 7.4, containing 0.02% sodium azide.

Ig Subclass: Rabbit IgG

Specificity: GenScript Rabbit Anti-Parvalbumin Polyclonal Antibody detects endogenous levels of human, mouse, and rat Parvalbumin.

Positive Control: Mouse brain and rat brain.

Purification: Immunoaffinity chromatography

Species Reactivity: Human, mouse, and rat. This product has not been tested for other species yet.

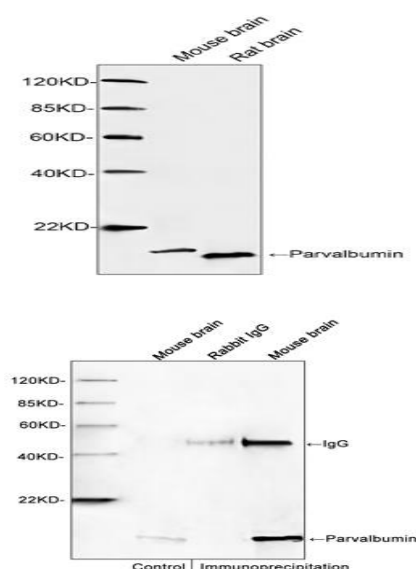
Reconstitution:

Reconstitute the lyophilized powder with deionized water (or equivalent) to antibody concentration of 0.5 mg/ml.

Storage:

The antibody is stable in lyophilized form if stored at -20°C or below. The reconstituted antibody can be stored for 2-3 weeks at 2-8°C. For long term storage, aliquot and store at -20°C or below. Avoid repeated freezing and thawing cycles.

Western blot analysis of tissue lysates using 1 µg/ml Rabbit Anti-Parvalbumin Polyclonal Antibody (GenScript, A01439)

The signal was developed with IRDye™ 800 Conjugated Goat Anti-Rabbit IgG.
