
Formulation	Lyophilized from 0.22µm filtered solution in PBS (pH 7.4). Normally 8% trehalose is added as protectant before lyophilization.
Reconstitution	Dissolve the lyophilized protein in distilled water. Please refer to the Certificate of Analysis for detailed instructions.
Storage	-20 to -80°C for 12 months as supplied from date of receipt80°C for 3 months after reconstitution.Recommend to aliquot the protein into smaller quantities for optimal storage. Please minimize freeze-thaw cycles.

Background

Signal regulatory protein α (SIRP α) is a regulatory membrane glycoprotein from SIRP family expressed mainly by myeloid cells and also by stem cells or neurons.SIRPα acts as inhibitory receptor and interacts with a broadly expressed transmembrane protein CD47 also called the "don't eat me" signal. Cancer cells highly expressed CD47 that activate SIRP α and inhibit macrophage-mediated destruction.




Human SIRP alpha V2 on Bis-Tris PAGE under reduced condition. The purity is greater than 95%..




The purity of Human SIRP alpha V2 is greater than 95% as determined by SEC-HPLC.

0.2μg Human CD47, His Tag Per Well


