Preparation before usage

1. Centrifuge at 7000rpm for 1 minute.
 2. Carefully open the vial and add 100ul of sterile water to dissolve the DNA.
- Each tube contains approximately 10ug of lyophilized plasmid.

Vector description

This shuttle vector contains the complete ORF. It is inseted Nde I to Xho I. The gene insert contains multiple cloning sites which can be used to easily cut and transfer the gene and recombination site into your expression vector.

pATGen (puc19-derived cloning vector)

General Description

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GLIPR2 is closely related to plant pathogenesis-related (PR-1) proteins, which are upregulated in response to pathogen attack. This protein is found within lipid-enriched microdomains on the cytosolic side of the endomembrane system. GLIPR2 is tightly anchored to membranes and absent from the cytosol, although it does not possess a membrane-spanning domain
