Can be stored at +2C to +8C for 1 week. For long term storage, aliquot and store at -20C to -80C. Avoid repeated freezing and thawing cycles.

BACKGROUND

Description

Syntaxin-2, also known as STX2, belongs to the syntaxin/epimorphin family of proteins. Syntaxin family is cellular receptors for transport vesicles which participate in exocytosis in neutrophils. STX2 is a t-SNARE that localizes to the apical plasma membrane and intracellular vesicular structures. Also, STX2, along with SNAP-23, is required for regulated surfactant secretion. Recombinant human STX2 protein, fused to His-tag at N-terminus, was expressed in E. coli and purified by using conventional chromatography techniques.

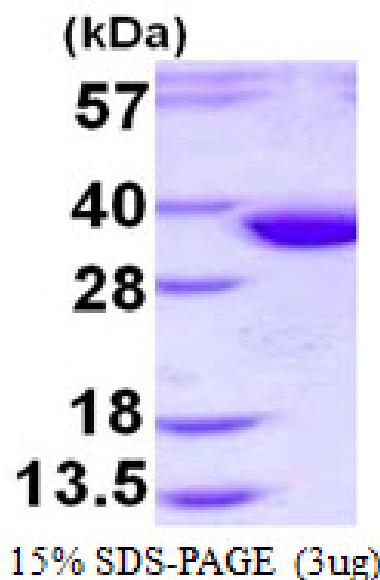
