Sequence information: A DNA sequence encoding the full length of human MAPK14 isoform 2 (NP_620581.1) (Met 1-Ser 360)

was fused with a polyhistidine tag at the carboxy-terminus.

Molecule Mass: The recombinant human MAPK14 consists of 370 amino acids and predicts amolecular mass of 42.8

kDa which is also estimated by SDS-PAGE.

Preparation Method: Cell lysate was prepared by homogenization in ice-cold modified RIPA Lysis Buffer with cocktail of

protease inhibitors (Sigma). Cell debris was removed by centrifugation. Protein concentration was determined by Bradford assay (Bio-Rad protein assay, Microplate Standard assay). The cell lysate was boiled for 5 min in 1 x SDS loading buffer (50 mM Tris-HCl pH 6.8, 12.5% glycerol, 1% sodium

dodecylsulfate, 0.01% bromophenol blue) containing 5% b-mercaptoethanol, and lyophilized.

Lysis Buffer: Modified RIPA Lysis Buffer: 50 mM Tris-HCl pH 7.4, 150 mM NaCl, 1mM EDTA, 1% Triton X-100, 0.1%

SDS, 1% Sodium deoxycholate, 1mM PMSF.

Quality Control Testing: 12.5% SDS-PAGE Stained with Coomassie Blue after protein purification.

Stability: Samples are stable for up to twelve months from date of receipt.

Recommend Usage:1. Centrifuge the tube for a few seconds and ensure the pellet at the bottom of the tube.

2. Re-dissolve the pellet using 200µL pure water and boil for 2-5 min.

3. Store the lyophilized cell lysate at 4°C. After re-dissolution, recommend to aliquot it into smaller

quantities and store at -80°C.

Storage Buffer: 1 X Sample Buffer (1 X modified RIPA buffer+1 X SDS loading buffer).

Storage Instruction: Store at 4°C. After re-dissolution, aliquot and store at -80°C.

Application notes: Western blot (WB): Use at an assay dependent dilution.

Other Applications: Not tested.

Optimal dilutions/concentrations should be determined by the end user.
