Protein Construction:

A DNA sequence encoding the human BST2 (Q10589) (Asn49-Ser160) was expressed, with an N-terminal polyhistidine tag.

Endotoxin:

< 1.0 EU per µg of the protein as determined by the LAL method

Stability:

Samples are stable for up to twelve months from date of receipt at -70 °C

Molecular Mass:

The recombinant human BST2 comprises 132 amino acids and has a predicted molecular mass of 14.9 kDa. The apparent molecular mass of the protein is approximately 23-26 kDa in SDS-PAGE under reducing conditions due to glycosylation.

Formulation:

Lyophilized from sterile PBS, pH 7.4

Normally 5 % - 8 % trehalose, mannitol and 0.01% Tween80 are added as protectants before lyophilization. Specific concentrations are included in the hardcopy of COA. Please contact us for any concerns or special requirements.

Usage Guide

Storage:

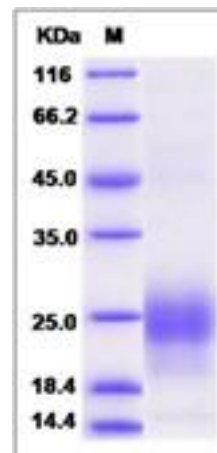
Store it under sterile conditions at -20°C to -80°C upon receiving. Recommend to aliquot the protein into smaller quantities for optimal storage.

Avoid repeated freeze-thaw cycles.
