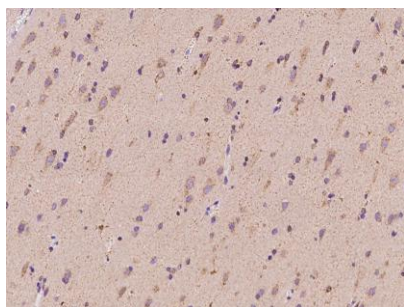

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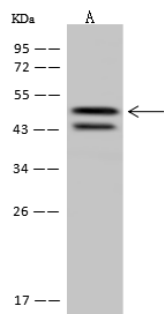

Secondary

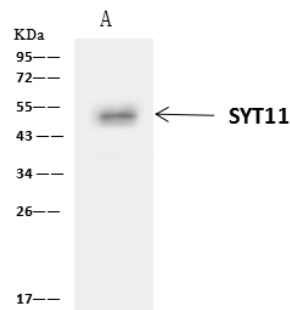
Goat Anti-Rabbit IgG (H+L)/HRP at 1/10000 dilution.
