Identical with the Gene Bank Ref. ID sequence except for the point mutation 1620 T/G not causing the amino acid variation.

pGEM-T

Shipping carrier :

Each tube contains approximately 10 µg of lyophilized plasmid.

Storage:

The lyophilized plasmid can be stored at ambient temperature for three months.

Quality control:

The plasmid is confirmed by full-length sequencing with primers in the sequencing primer list.

Sequencing primer list:

M13-47: 5' GCCAGGGTTTTCCCAGTCACGAC 3'

RV-M: 5' GAGCGGATAACAATTTCACACAGG 3'

Other M13 primers can also be used as sequencing primers.

Plasmid Resuspension protocol

- 1. Centrifuge at $5,000 \times g$ for 5 min.
- 2. Carefully open the tube and add 100 μ l of sterile water to dissolve the DNA.
- 3. Close the tube and incubate for 10 minutes at room temperature.
- 4. Briefly vortex the tube and then do a quick spin to concentrate the liquid at the bottom. Speed is less than $5000 \times \alpha$.
- 5. Store the plasmid at $-20 \, ^{\circ}\mathrm{C}$.

The plasmid is ready for:

- · Restriction enzyme digestion
- PCR amplification
- · E. coli transformation
- DNA sequencing

E.coli strains for transformation (recommended but not limited)

Most commercially available competent cells are appropriate for the plasmid, e.g. TOP10, DH5 α and TOP10F $\dot{}$.
