Identical with the Gene Bank Ref. ID sequence except for the point mutations: 1811 C/T, 2567 T/C resulting in the amino acid thr substitution by met, met substitution by thr and 300 C/T, 1956 C/T, 2514 G/A, 2730 C/T, 2796 A/G, 2925 A/T, 3132 C/T not causing the amino acid variation.

Shipping carrier:

Each tube contains approximately 10 µg of lyophilized plasmid.

Storage:

The lyophilized plasmid can be stored at ambient temperature for three months.

Quality control:

The plasmid is confirmed by full-length sequencing with primers in the sequencing primer list.

Sequencing primer list:

M13-47: 5' GCCAGGGTTTTCCCAGTCACGAC 3'

RV-M: 5' GAGCGGATAACAATTTCACACAGG 3'

Other M13 primers can also be used as sequencing primers.

Plasmid Resuspension protocol

- 1. Centrifuge at $5,000 \times g$ for 5 min.
- 2.Carefully open the tube and add 100 µl of sterile water to dissolve the DNA.
- 3. Close the tube and incubate for 10 minutes at room temperature.
- 4. Briefly vortex the tube and then do a quick spin to concentrate the liquid at the bottom. Speed is less than 5000×g.
- 5.Store the plasmid at -20 °C.

The plasmid is ready for:

- · Restriction enzyme digestion
- PCR amplification
- · E. coli transformation
- DNA sequencing

E.coli strains for transformation (recommended but not limited)

Most commercially available competent cells are appropriate for the plasmid, e.g. TOP10, DH5α and TOP10F'.

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Vector Information

The pGEM-T vector is a high-efficiency TA cloning vector which contains multiple cloning sites as shown below. The pGEM-T vector is 3.0kb in size and contains the amplicin resistance gene for selection. The coding sequence was inserted by TA cloning.
