Each tube contains approximately 10 µg of lyophilized plasmid.

Storage:

The lyophilized plasmid can be stored at ambient temperature for three months.

Quality control:

The plasmid is confirmed by full-length sequencing with primers in the sequencing primer list.

Other M13 primers can also be used as sequencing primers.

Plasmid Resuspension protocol

- 1.Centrifuge at $5,000 \times g$ for 5 min.
- 2.Carefully open the tube and add 100 $\,\mu l$ of sterile water to dissolve the DNA.
- 3.Close the tube and incubate for 10 minutes at room temperature.
- 4.Briefly vortex the tube and then do a quick spin to concentrate the liquid at the bottom. Speed is less than $5000 \times g$.
- 5.Store the plasmid at -20 °C.

The plasmid is ready for:

- · Restriction enzyme digestion
- · PCR amplification
- · E. coli transformation
- DNA sequencing

E.coli strains for transformation (recommended but not limited)

Most commercially available competent cells are appropriate for the plasmid, e.g. TOP10, DH5 α and TOP10F $^{\prime}$.
