Function	The PR65 subunit of protein phosphatase 2A serves as a scaffolding molecule to coordinate the assembly of the catalytic subunit and a variable regulatory B subunit. Upon interaction with GNA12 promotes dephosphorylation of microtubule associated protein TAU/MAPT . Required for proper chromosome segregation and for centromeric localization of SGO1 in mitosis .
Sequence and Domain Family	Each HEAT repeat appears to consist of two alpha helices joined by a hydrophilic region, the intrarepeat loop. The repeat units may be arranged laterally to form a rod-like structure.
Cellular Localization	Cytoplasm Chromosome, centromere Lateral cell membrane Cell projection, dendrite. Centromeric localization requires the presence of BUB1.

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
