RNF123

Catalytic subunit of the KPC complex that acts as E3 ubiquitin-protein ligase. **Function**

Required for poly-ubiquitination and proteasome-mediated degradation of

CDKN1B during G1 phase of the cell cycle.

Cellular Localization Cytoplasm

Ubiquitinated, leading to its degradation. Deubiquitinated by USP19, thereby Post-translational

stimulating CDKN1B ubiquitin-dependent degradation. **Modifications**

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
