Function Transcriptional corepressor. Acts as dominant repressor towards other family

members. Inhibits NF-kappa-B-regulated gene expression. May be required for the initiation and maintenance of the differentiated state. Essential for the transcriptional repressor activity of SIX3 during retina and lens development.

Sequence and Domain Family Lacks the C-terminal WD repeats.

Cellular Localization Nucleus

Post-translational Ubiquitinated by XIAP/BIRC4.
