Function Plays a role in cell attachment and migration. Interacts with extracellular

> matrix proteins and with the actin cytoskeleton. Mediates adhesion of cells to type 1 collagen and gelatin, reorganization of the actin cytoskeleton and promotes cell spreading. Plays a role in the angiogenic response of cultured

umbilical vein endothelial cells.

Sequence and Domain Family Binding to PA occurs through the VWA domain.

Cell membrane Cell projection, lamellipodium membrane Cell projection, **Cellular Localization**

> filopodium membrane. At the membrane of lamellipodia and at the tip of actin-enriched filopodia. Colocalizes with actin at the base of lamellipodia.
