**Function** Probable G-protein coupled receptor implicated in a large repertoire of

behavioral responses that engage motor activities, spatial learning, and

emotional processing. May play a role in the regulation of cognitive and motor

function.

Cellular Localization Cell membrane Cytoplasm Nucleus. During cortical lamination, subcellular

location shifts, on the day of birth, from expression at the plasma membrane and in the cytoplasm to the nuclei of neurons. This intranuclear localization

remains throughout adulthood.

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
