Tissue Specificity Isoform 1 is only expressed in skeletal muscle. Isoform 2 is constitutively

expressed in skeletal muscle, brain, heart, kidney, liver, lung and thymus.

Purification The antibody was affinity-purified from rabbit antiserum by affinity-

chromatography using epitope-specific immunogen.

Function After binding acetylcholine, the AChR responds by an extensive change in

conformation that affects all subunits and leads to opening of an ion-

conducting channel across the plasma membrane.
