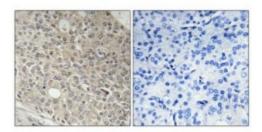

Function Inhibits the Wnt/beta-catenin signaling pathway, probably by recruiting

CTNNB1 to recycling endosomes and hence preventing its translocation to the

nucleus.
