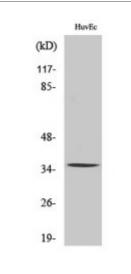

Function Forms a water-specific channel. Implicated in the generation of saliva, tears,

and pulmonary secretions. Required for TRPV4 activation by hypotonicity . Together with TRPV4, controls regulatory volume decrease in salivary

epithelial cells.

Sequence and Domain Family Aquaporins contain two tandem repeats each containing three membrane-

spanning domains and a pore-forming loop with the signature motif Asn-Pro-

Ala (NPA).
