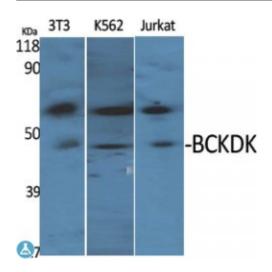

Function Catalyzes the phosphorylation and inactivation of the branched-chain alpha-

ketoacid dehydrogenase complex, the key regulatory enzyme of the valine, leucine and isoleucine catabolic pathways. Key enzyme that regulate the

activity state of the BCKD complex.
