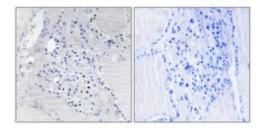

Tissue Specificity Expressed in ovary, testis, placenta, skeletal muscle, kidney, lung, heart and

liver (at protein level). Expressed in thymus and brain.

Purification The antibody was affinity-purified from rabbit antiserum by affinity-

chromatography using epitope-specific immunogen.

Function Plays a role in inhibiting the effects of BCL10-induced activation of NF-

kappa-B. May inhibit the phosphorylation of BCL10 in a CARD-dependent

manner.

Cellular Localization Isoform 1: Nucleus. Coexpression with BCL10 induced translocation from

nucleus to cytosol.. Isoform 2: Endoplasmic reticulum membrane
