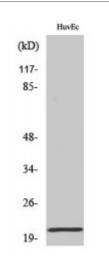


## **Anti-Cardiotrophin-1 antibody**

**Specificity** Cardiotrophin-1 Polyclonal Antibody detects endogenous levels of

Cardiotrophin-1 protein.

**Tissue Specificity** Highly expressed in heart, skeletal muscle, prostate and ovary. Lower levels in

lung, kidney, pancreas, thymus, testis and small intestine. Little or no expression in brain, placenta, liver, spleen, colon or peripheral blood

leukocytes.

**Purification** The antibody was affinity-purified from rabbit antiserum by affinity-

chromatography using epitope-specific immunogen.
