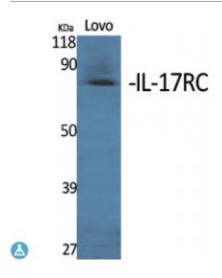

Specificity IL-17RC Polyclonal Antibody detects endogenous levels of IL-17RC protein.

Tissue Specificity Expressed in prostate, skeletal muscle, kidney and placenta (at protein level).

Expressed in brain, cartilage, colon, heart, intestine, kidney, liver, lung, muscle, placenta, and prostate . Also detected in thyroid, trachea and adrenal

gland. Low expression in thymus and leukocytes.

Purification The antibody was affinity-purified from rabbit antiserum by affinity-

chromatography using epitope-specific immunogen.

Function Receptor for IL17A and IL17F homodimers as part of a heterodimeric

complex with IL17RA . Receptor for the heterodimer formed by IL17A and IL17B as part of a heterodimeric complex with IL17RA . Has also been shown to be the cognate receptor for IL17F and to bind IL17A with high affinity without the need for IL17RA . Activation of IL17RC leads to induction of expression of inflammatory chemokines and cytokines such as CXCL1 . Isoform 5: Receptor for both IL17A and IL17F. Isoform 6: Does not bind IL17A or IL17F. Isoform 7: Does not bind IL17A or IL17F. Isoform 8:

Receptor for both IL17A and IL17F.

Cellular Localization Cell membrane. Soluble isoforms may be produced.
