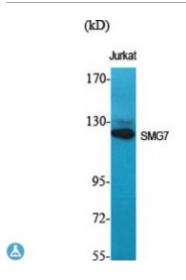

Function Plays a role in nonsense-mediated mRNA decay. Recruits UPF1 to

cytoplasmic mRNA decay bodies. Together with SMG5 is thought to provide

a link to the mRNA degradation machinery involving exonucleolytic pathways, and to serve as an adapter for UPF1 to protein phosphatase 2A

(PP2A), thereby triggering UPF1 dephosphorylation.

Cellular Localization Cytoplasm. Nucleus. Predominantly cytoplasmic, and nuclear. Shuttles

between nucleus and cytoplasm.

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
