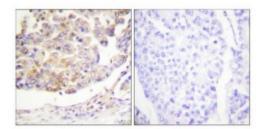

Specificity Vav Polyclonal Antibody detects endogenous levels of Vav protein.

Tissue Specificity Widely expressed in hematopoietic cells but not in other cell types.

Purification The antibody was affinity-purified from rabbit antiserum by affinity-

chromatography using epitope-specific immunogen.
