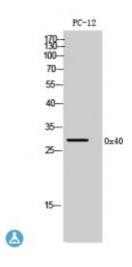


## Anti-Ox40 antibody



**Description** Rabbit polyclonal to Ox40.

**Specificity** Ox40 Polyclonal Antibody detects endogenous levels of Ox40 protein.

**Purification** The antibody was affinity-purified from rabbit antiserum by affinity-

chromatography using epitope-specific immunogen.

**Function** Receptor for TNFSF4/OX40L/GP34. Is a costimulatory molecule implicated

in long-term T-cell immunity. (Microbial infection) Acts as a receptor for

human herpesvirus 6B/HHV-6B.

Cellular Localization Membrane. Single-pass type I membrane protein.

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
