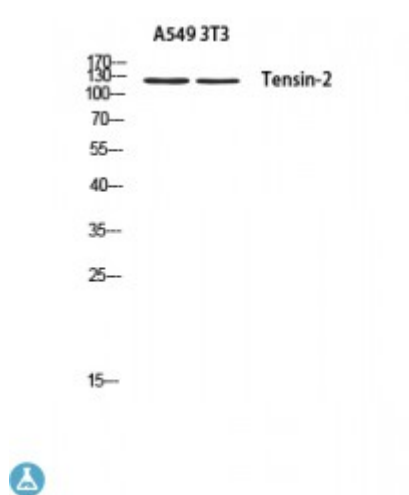


Anti-Tensin-2 antibody

Specificity	Tensin-2 Polyclonal Antibody detects endogenous levels of Tensin-2 protein.
Tissue Specificity	Detected in heart, kidney, brain, thymus, spleen, liver, placenta, lung, skeletal muscle and small intestine.
Purification	The antibody was affinity-purified from rabbit antiserum by affinity-chromatography using epitope-specific immunogen.

Alternative Names	Tensin-2 C1 domain-containing phosphatase and tensin homolog C1-TEN Tensin-like C1 domain-containing phosphatase
Function	Regulates cell motility and proliferation. May have phosphatase activity. Reduces AKT1 phosphorylation. Lowers AKT1 kinase activity and interferes with AKT1 signaling.
Cellular Localization	Cell junction, focal adhesion Cell membrane. Detected at the end of actin stress fibers. Detected in cytoplasmic punctate bodies .

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
