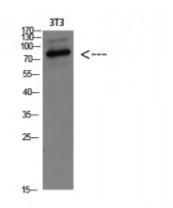


## **Anti-GRP78 BiP antibody**





**Description** Rabbit polyclonal to GRP78 BiP.

**Function** Probably plays a role in facilitating the assembly of multimeric protein

complexes inside the endoplasmic reticulum. Involved in the correct folding of proteins and degradation of misfolded proteins via its interaction with DNAJC10, probably to facilitate the release of DNAJC10 from its substrate.

**Cellular Localization** Endoplasmic reticulum lumen Melanosome. Cytoplasm. Identified by mass

spectrometry in melanosome fractions from stage I to stage IV.

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
