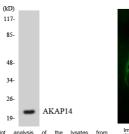

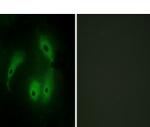

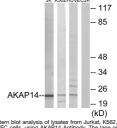

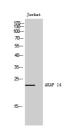


Western blot analysis of the lysates RAW264.7cells using AKAP14 antibody.
