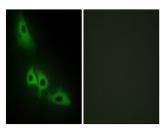

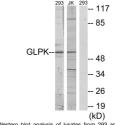
Immunogen 430-510 C-Term Region

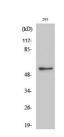
Specificity GK polyclonal antibody (Glycerol Kinase) binds to endogenous Glycerol Kinase at the amino acid region 430-510 C-Term.
