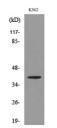

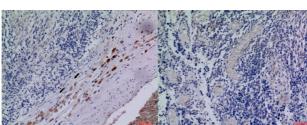

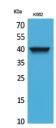


Western blot analysis of lysate from K562 cells, using CXCR3 Antibody.
