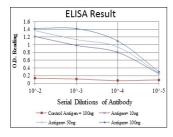

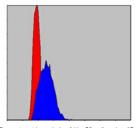

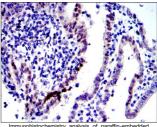

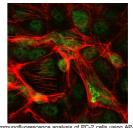




Flow cytometric analysis of HepG2 cells using AP-1 monoclonal antibody (blue) and negative control (red).
