
## **Chemical Properties**

# **Biological Description**

Description	3,5-Diiodothyropropionic acid is a thyroid hormone analog. It induces $\alpha$ -myosin heavy chain mRNA expression, binds to thyroid hormone receptor (Ka: 2.40/M and 4.06/M for TR $\alpha$ 1 and TR $\beta$ 1).
