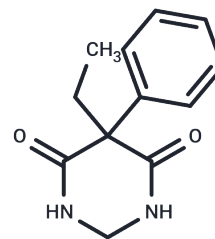

Description	Primidone (NCI-C56360) is a potent anticonvulsant agent. It is a neuronal voltage-gated sodium channel blocker and has value in the study of epilepsy, essential tremor, and psychiatric disorders.
