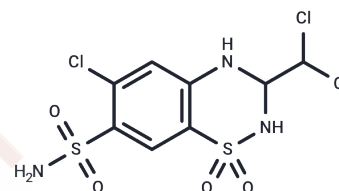


Trichlormethiazide

Biological Description

Description	Trichlormethiazide (Naqua) is a short-acting, 3-dichloromethyl derivative of hydrochlorothiazide, belonging to the class of thiazide diuretics. Trichlormethiazide appears to block the active reabsorption of chloride and possibly sodium in the ascending loop of Henle, altering electrolyte transfer in the proximal tubule.
Targets(IC ₅₀)	ATPase,Carbonic Anhydrase

Solubility Information

Solubility	DMSO: 50 mg/mL (131.35 mM),Sonication is recommended. Ethanol: < 1 mg/mL (insoluble or slightly soluble), H ₂ O: < 1 mg/mL (insoluble or slightly soluble), (< 1 mg/ml refers to the product slightly soluble or insoluble)
