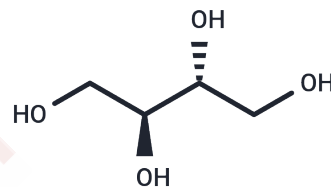


## meso-Erythritol

## Biological Description

Description	meso-Erythritol (Phycitol) is a four-carbon sugar that is found in algae, fungi, and lichens. It is twice as sweet as sucrose and can be used as a coronary vasodilator.
Targets(IC50)	Endogenous Metabolite
In vivo	After oral administration, erythritol is rapidly absorbed from the gastrointestinal tract and subsequently excreted swiftly in its original form through the urine.

## Solubility Information

Solubility	H <sub>2</sub> O: 22 mg/mL (180.15 mM), Sonication is recommended. DMSO: 55 mg/mL (450.38 mM), Sonication is recommended. Ethanol: < 1 mg/mL (insoluble or slightly soluble), (< 1 mg/ml refers to the product slightly soluble or insoluble)
