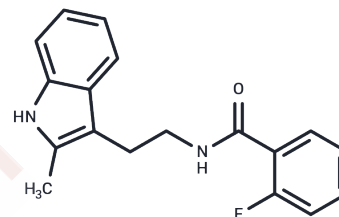

Biological Description

Description	CK-666 is a cell-permeable inhibitor of the actin-related protein Arp2/3 complex, binding to and stabilizing its inactive state, thereby preventing the movement of the Arp2 and Arp3 subunits into the activated filament-like (short pitch) configuration.
