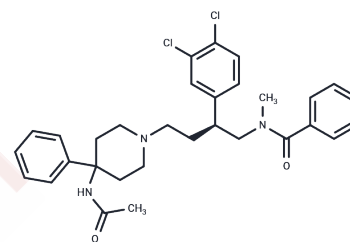

Biological Description

Description	Saredutant (SR 48968) is a selective neurokinin-2 (NK2) receptor antagonist that inhibits the action of neurokinin A by blocking the NK2 receptor, thereby exerting antidepressant and anxiolytic effects.
Targets(IC50)	Others
In vivo	In FSL rats, oral Saredutant (1-10mg/kg, 14 days) dose-dependently enhanced social interaction and reduced immobility, with no effect in control rats. Combined with subeffective desipramine, it showed synergistic antidepressant effects[1].
