Description	Biotin-PEG12-TFP ester is a PEG-based linker for PROTACs that joins two essential ligands, crucial for forming PROTAC molecules, and enables selective protein degradation by leveraging the ubiquitin-proteasome system within cells.
Targets(IC50)	Others
In vitro	PROTACs, consisting of two ligands joined by a linker, bind an E3 ubiquitin ligase and the target protein. They harness the intracellular ubiquitin-proteasome system to selectively degrade target proteins [1].
