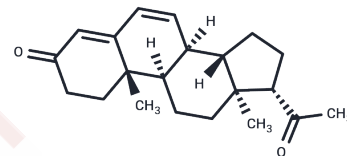

Biological Description

Description	Dydrogesterone is a potent progestogen which can be used in progesterone deficiency studies.
Targets(IC50)	Progesterone Receptor
In vitro	Dydrogesterone is orally active at far lower doses. Its freedom from estrogenic, androgenic, anabolic, corticoid and other undesirable hormonal effects gives it additional benefits over most other synthetic progestogens[1].
