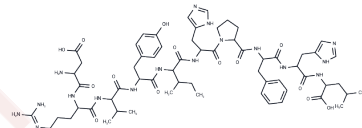

Biological Description

Description	Angiotensin I (human, mouse, rat) is the precursor to the vasoconstrictor peptide angiotensin II, cleaved by the angiotensin-converting enzyme (ACE). This peptide hormone causes vasoconstriction and increases blood pressure as part of the renin-angiotensin system, also stimulating aldosterone release from the adrenal cortex to promote sodium retention by the kidneys.
